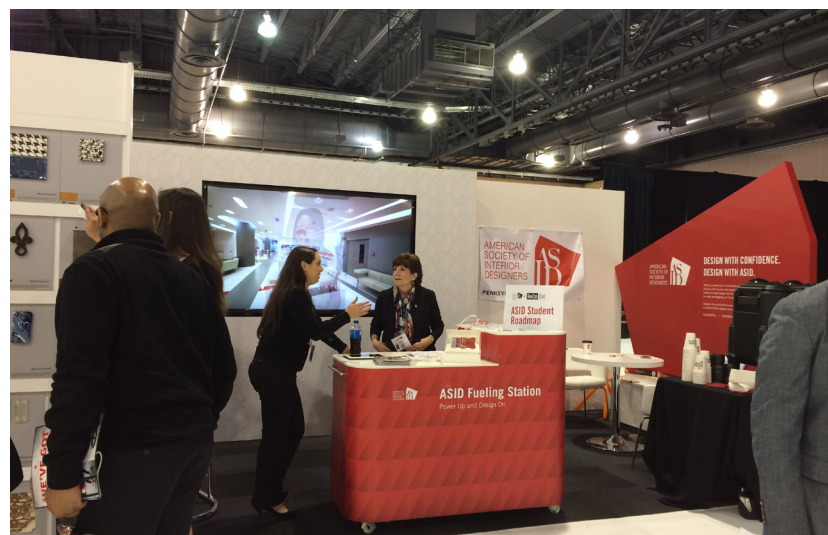

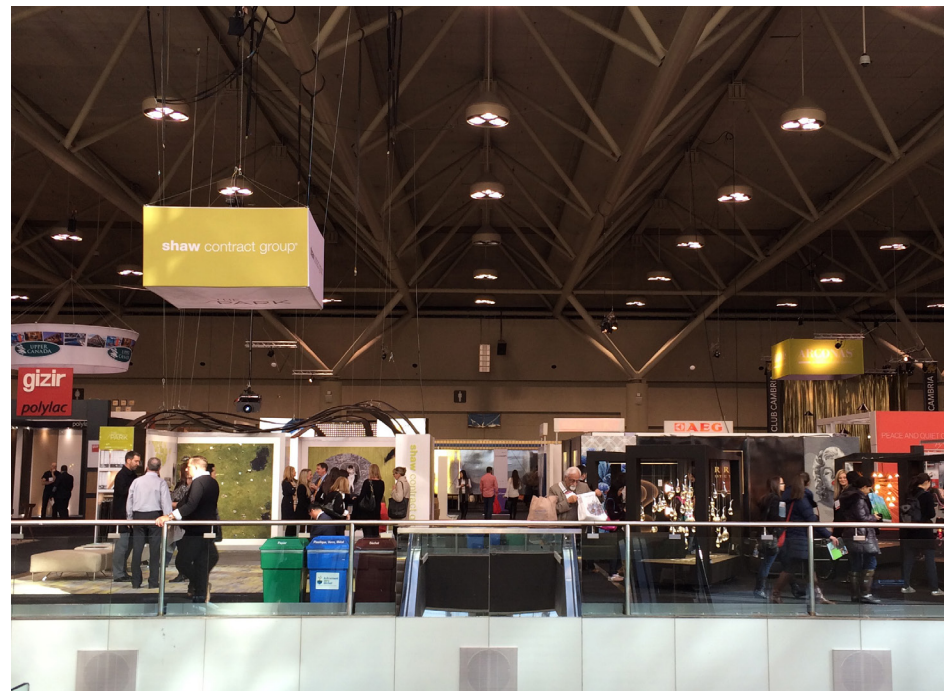

IIDEX RECAP

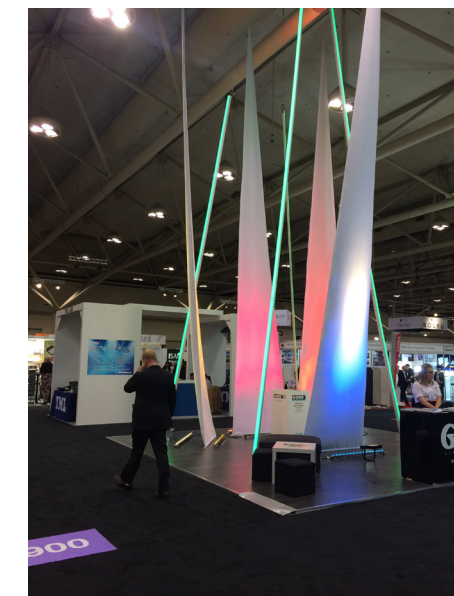

NCIDQ DEADLINES

Are you planning to sit for the NCIDQ exam? Make note of the following deadlines:

February 10th - Last day to register for Spring 2016 PRAC without late fee.

April 2nd - Spring PRAC exam administered.

April 14th-23rd - Spring IDFX+IDPX administered.

July 15th - Fall exam application approval deadline.

August 10th - Last day to register for Fall 2016 PRAC without late fee.

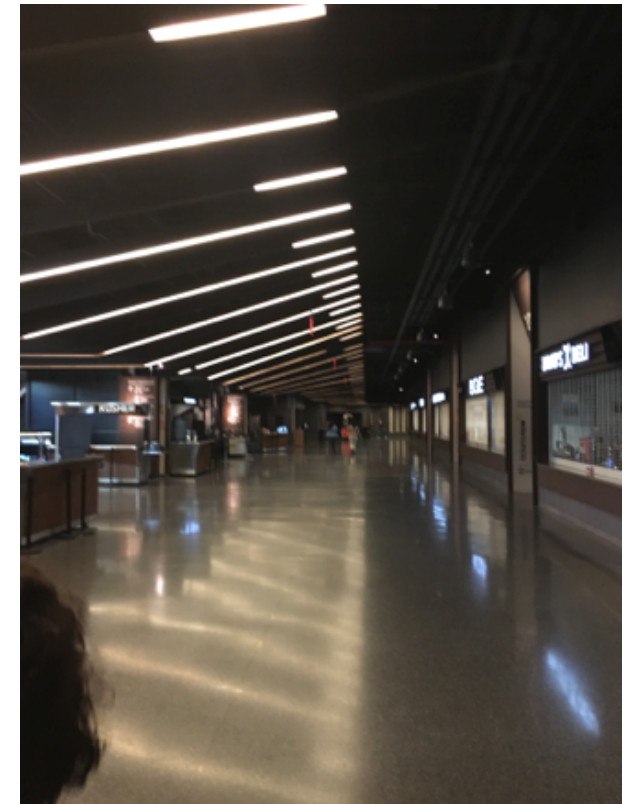
